APPLICANT: Bering Straits Native Corporation

PROJECT NAME: LAS 31581

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: Located on the north-east side of Kodiak Island, on the west side of Woody Island, approximately 600ft north-east of Icehouse Point and approximately 550ft west of Mirror Lake.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: NW ¼ SE ¼ NE ¼ Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 19 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: Applicant is requesting to establish one barge landing site on State-owned tidelands to facilitate the removal of the Federal Aviation Administration's Woody Island Pier including bulkhead, decking, and treated pilings. Applicant is requesting off road travel to remove pier with the use of excavators on the shore and from the barge for the submerged portion of the pier.

End: May 3, 2017

The public is invited to comment on the proposed activity.
