APPLICANT: Jack Martin

PROJECT NAME: LAS 31696

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: Located on the Kenai Peninsula, near Kasilof, on the west side of Coho Loop Road, in between milepost 5 and 5.5 and approximately 1.6 miles west of Upper Coho Lake.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: NE ¼, SW ¼, SW ¼, Section 21, Township 003 North, Range 012 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: Applicant is requesting to establish a camp consisting of two 12' x 24' cabins, one 8' x 30' steel container and the storage of six 8' x 24' boats, five pick-up trucks, three gantry trailers, nets, and gear associated with a commercial set net operation. The camp would be actively used during the months of mid-June through mid-August, and as storage for the remainder of the year.

PROPOSED DATES OF USE:

Start: July 1, 2017

End: June 30, 2021

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: August 3, 2017

The public is invited to comment on the proposed activity.
