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DIRECTOR'S ORDER REGARDING FEES

Director's Fee Order Number 2

After considering the 1) estimated actual costs of the authorization, petition, or service to the Department of Natural Resources, (2) the economic needs of the Department of Natural Resources; and (3) the public interest, I have determined that it is in the interest of the Department of Natural Resources to approve a waiver to reduce the following fees to the amounts listed in this order.

These fee waiver reductions will take effect 30 days after the date this order is published on the division's public internet webpage and the Alaska Online Public Notice System. These fees waiver reductions apply to all applicants or petitioners for each authorization, petition, or service, do not exceed 20 percent of the amount established in 11 AAC 05 and, do not waive or reduce any additional fees for which waiver is prohibited under 11 AAC 05.

This Director's Order supersedes and replaces Director's Fee Order No. 1.
