Subject to AS 38.05.850, the Southcentral Regional Land Office has received an application for the following:

APPLICANT: Matanuska Susitna Borough

PROJECT NAME: LAS 32600

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: Along a 800-900 foot portion of a section line easement at milepost 111.5 of the Parks Highway.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: The section line between Sections 8 and 17 of Township 25 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: Cross country travel of heavy equipment including the use of a log skidder, feller buncher, log truck, bulldozer, and pickup truck across a route that includes approximately 800-900 feet of state land for the purpose of removing spruce trees infested with or killed by spruce bark beetles.

PROPOSED DATES OF USE: Start: October 1, 2018 End: September 30, 2023

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: October 29, 2018

The public is invited to comment on this activity. The purpose of this notice is to gather input before a decision is made on this activity.
