The following question has been submitted by the vendor community in response to this ITB.

Question 1: How will subsequent contract years be treated if ADOT drastically exceeds 300,000 SMS and/or 1,000,000 email in year 1?

Answer 1: In the event AK DOT&PF exceeds the estimated annual quantities identified in the RFP in any year of the proposed contract by more than 50%, the state will negotiate a new rates based on the increased volume in good faith with the contractor for the following year. Based on a higher volume of messages, while the state's total monthly cost may increase, the state would expect to see a reduced per message cost for following year.
