Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The Department of Labor and Workforce Development adopted the regulations after the close of the public comment period. The regulations increase the time period from 10 days to 15 days for an employee to seek review by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development of a no-merit determination by the Director of Labor Standards and Safety of the employee's complaint for discrimination against an employer under AS 18.60.089.

Both the December 23, 2022 public notice and the May 12, 2023 order adopting changes to the regulations state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
