Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Nursing against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Nursing after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations amend 12 AAC 44 to update requirements related to license and certification procedures, license reinstatement, and license renewal. Additionally, the regulations amend 12 AAC 44.740 to add two new subsections setting out an alternative probation program for a licensee to meet the terms of board-imposed probation for habitual drug and alcohol use; opportunity to participate is offered at the discretion of the board and kept confidential except as required by law.

Both the December 20, 2022 public notice and the February 2, 2023 certification of changes to the regulations state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060. The corrections are incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations. Although the order certifying changes refers to nine pages of regulations, after edits the regulations are now six pages.
