Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations concern preceptor requirements, clarifying that registration as a preceptor by the North American Registry of Midwives (NARM) is required to be a preceptor of apprentice midwives.

The August 13, 2023, public notice and the November 8, 2023, certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.

ORDER CERTIFYING THE CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF CERTIFIED DIRECT-ENTRY MIDWIVES

The attached two pages of regulations, dealing with preceptor requirements, clarifying that registration as a preceptor by the North American Registry of Midwives (NARM) is required to be a preceptor of apprentices, are certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives adopted at its November 8, 2023 meeting, under the authority of AS 08.65.030, AS 08.65.050, and AS 08.65.090, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

Although no public comments were received, the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes described in this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.
