Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Health against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Health after the close of the public comment period.

Implementing legislation recently enacted under ch 16, SLA 2023 (HCS SB 58(FIN)), the regulations concern Medicaid eligibility, coverage, and payment for pregnancy and postpartum mothers.

The October 18, 2023 public notice and the December 19, 2023 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

Additionally, the adoption order sets out a special effective date of February 1, 2024. Accordingly, we respectfully request filing of the regulations on or before January 2, 2024.

We have made some technical corrections to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060. The corrections are incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations.
