This amendment has two parts:

Part 1: This amendment adds language to the Body of Notice.

The TPC Program expects to fund *comprehensive* tobacco prevention and control efforts statewide as described within the RFP, its Appendices, and Attachments.

In the past, the program has separated this work out by CDC Component area and administered three grant programs to work specifically in Community Prevention, Youth and Schools K-12 and Cessation. As our work and program have evolved over the years, so has the method in which we work. With the programs successes in regional collaborations and partnerships, the TPC reorganized the funding schematic to reflect and support this regional work. As such, the TPC will now fund each region and grantee to provide comprehensive tobacco prevention practices inclusive all the work that was previously segmented into the three separate grant programs mentioned above. In sum, each grantee and region will be funded to carry out all program strategies, as described in the RFP.

Part 2: This amendment clarifies the funding language found on page 16, Section 1.06 of the RFP.

The RFP states "The TPC Program anticipates awarding approximately \$400,000 per organization to include approximately 12 regional grantees and 2 statewide grantees, for a total of 14 for this grant cycle."

Clarification: The TPC Program anticipates awarding approximately \$400,000 per organization, <u>per fiscal year</u>, to include approximately 12 regional grantees and 2 statewide grantees, for a total of 14 for this grant cycle.
