Experience as an administrator does not constitute "teaching experience" in regards to this CFA. An applicant's failure to meet the minimum experience requirement will cause their application to be considered non-responsive and their application will be rejected.

I am a retired teacher with a Retired (Lifetime) Certificate. I do not have any of the certificates listed in Section 7 on the Application cover sheet. Should I attach my Lifetime Certificate?
