Title 7. Health and Social Services.

7 AAC 12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

7 AAC 12.185. Reporting of hospital and ambulatory surgical center discharge data.

- (a) A hospital and ambulatory surgical center required to be licensed under AS 47.32 and this chapter, and a hospital and ambulatory surgical center that submits claims for reimbursement under 7 AAC 105 160, shall submit to the department, or to a department contractor, discharge data for all discharges from inpatient, emergency department, outpatient, and ambulatory surgical services.
- (b) Discharge data shall be submitted in a format and include data elements based on National Uniform Billing Data Element Specifications, as designated by the department, and shall be submitted at least quarterly within 60 days of the end of each calendar quarter.
- (c) The department may issue sanctions against a facility that submits claims for reimbursement under 7~AAC~105-160 for failure to submit hospital discharge data under this section.
- (d) Information held by the department as a result of reporting under this section is not subject to subpoena, discovery, or introduction into evidence in any civil or criminal proceeding; provided that the information otherwise available from other sources is not immune from subpoena, discovery, or introduction into evidence through those sources solely because the information was reported as required by this section.
