## AMENDMENT TO INVITATION FOR BID

**The following is the University response to all questions that have been submitted to date:**

1. Question: "Installation (Supervised installation and training by a vendor representative for initial setup and take down)" – In terms of this requirement, should we plan on organizing our own group of staff to install the entire stage, sound wings, and 2 ramps as well as disassemble the structures in their entirety? Or will U of A be providing the "building staff"/man power for one of our supervisors to train your team to build and disassemble the structures?

Answer: The University will be providing staff/man power for the installation and breakdown of the stage. We are asking for a representative from the successful bidder to be present to guide our staff in assembly and disassembly of the stage.

2. Question: In terms of the stage, where would you like the guardrails placed? – typically they run along the back of the stage and around the 2 sides of the stage. It is understood that they do need to run along the entire length of both of the ramps as by definition - they are ADA wheelchair ramps, so that aspect is clear. Since the requirement doesn't call out a distinction between the ramps vs stage, I just want to make sure we are all on the same page here. Also I understand the sound wings do not need any guardrails, correct?

Answer: Correct, the Guardrails need to be able to attach to the back and sides of the stage, Handrails on both sides of the ramps and stairs as required, and no guardrails required for the sound wings.

3. Question: In terms of storage carts – Does the University want to store all stage decks, legs for stage, guardrails for stage; as well as all of the same for the sound wings?

Answer: This is correct, carts sufficient for movement and storage of entire stage, barricade and non-wheeled accessories.
