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**The following questions have been asked and answered:**

**Q:** Tasks II and III of the requested work scope include wording related to assessment and provision of remedial strategies and costs. Since the work is to be conducted in accordance with ASTM Phase 1 Standards is the DCCED comfortable with these estimates being generated in the absence of sampling?

**A:** Yes. It is important to understand offerors must develop a cleanup strategy not perform the actual cleanup. Proposals are sought for developing the strategy only.

**Q:** Attachment 5 - IRFP Cost Schedule comprises lump sum costs for Tasks I-III. Does the DCCED also require a more detailed cost estimate?

**A:** Not at this time, though it may be required for the winning Offeror.

**Q:** How extensive and detailed should the experience documentation be for personnel having significantly more than 3 years' experience?

**A:** Page nine (9) identifies the prior experience requirements necessary for offerors to be deemed responsive: "three (3) years' experience in each of the following: The inventory and assessment of hazardous waste; and The development of timelines or strategies for hazardous waste cleanup. Evidence of meeting the minimum prior experience must be shown in the Experience & Qualifications section of the offeror's proposal." This is pass/fail criteria.

Page 13 (Attachment 1 Proposal Evaluation Form) outlines the point value assigned (200) for the Experience and Qualifications. Offers' proposals should identify the education and experience of the personnel designated to work on the project.
