Dear licensees and interested parties:

Alaska's professional licensing statutes (AS 08.01.065) require the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL) to "annually review each fee level to determine whether the regulatory costs of each occupation are approximately equal to fee collections related to that occupation." Alaska's licensing fee statutes go on to say, "If the review indicates that an occupation's fee collections and regulatory costs are not approximately equal, the department shall calculate fee adjustments and adopt regulations...to implement the adjustments."

The division proposes increasing licensing fee amounts in order to comply with the statute listed above, as well as to continue to deliver its current level of service for the midwifery licensing program.

The Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives moved and approved at its August 2012 meeting to increase apprentice fees to 50% of the midwives' fees. A breakdown of the proposed fees is enclosed and located on the Board's web page at <http://commerce.alaska.gov/dnn/cbpl/ProfessionalLicensing/Midwives.aspx>.

This fee proposal will enter a public comment period this week. The division encourages all licensees and interested parties to comment on this proposal through the division's Regulations Specialist, whose contact information is enclosed on the public notice. After the comment period closes and the division reviews all comments received, the division may adopt the regulation as drafted, may amend a proposed fee, or may withdraw the regulations in part or in its whole.

All comments received will be reviewed and taken into consideration prior to adopting the final regulations. The final decision will result in the fee to be implemented during this winter's license renewal.

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to change occupational license fees charged to direct-entry midwives and apprentices.

The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 12, Chapter 02 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with occupational licensing fees related to the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives, including the following:

**12 AAC 02.145, Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives**, is proposed to be changed to alter the certification, permit, and renewal fees for direct-entry midwives and apprentices.

Under AS 08.01.065, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development must establish fee levels so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development has reviewed the income and expenses for the occupational licensing program for the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives and proposes fee changes that reflect, to the extent possible, the actual costs of the activities related to the program.

**Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.**

(Words in **boldface and underlined** indicate language being added; words [CAPITALIZED AND BRACKETED] indicate language being deleted.

12 AAC 02.145 is amended to read:

**12 AAC 02.145. Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives.** The following fees are established for direct-entry midwives and apprentices:

- (1) nonrefundable application fee for initial certification, \$250;
- (2) certification fee for all or part of the initial biennial certification period, **\$1,750** [\$1,450];
- (3) biennial certification renewal fee, **\$1,750** [\$1,450];
- (4) apprentice direct-entry midwife permit fee, **\$825** [\$125];
- (5) biennial apprentice direct-entry midwife permit renewal fee, **\$825** [\$125];
- (6) nonrefundable application fee for initial apprentice direct-entry midwife permit, \$125. (Eff. 1/22/93, Register 125; am 10/29/94, Register 132; am 11/15/96, Register 140; am 5/5/99, Register 150; am 10/28/2000, Register 156; am 11/15/2002, Register 164; am 10/15/2004, Register 172; am 10/31/2008, Register 188; am 12/3/2010, Register 196; am 12/2/2012, Register 204; am \_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_, Register \_\_\_\_)
