Dear licensees and interested parties:

Alaska's professional licensing statutes (AS 08.01.065) require the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL) to "annually review each fee level to determine whether the regulatory costs of each occupation are approximately equal to fee collections related to that occupation." Alaska's licensing fee statutes go on to say, "If the review indicates that an occupation's fee collections and regulatory costs are not approximately equal, the department shall calculate fee adjustments and adopt regulations...to implement the adjustments."

With the addition of a statutorily dedicated investigator, as well as the higher legal and regulatory activity of the Board of Dental Examiners during this time period, the division proposed increasing licensing fee amounts in order to comply with the statute listed above and to continue to deliver its current level of service for the dental licensing program.

The Board moved and approved at their September 5, 2014, meeting to increase the application, anesthetic, and sedation fees above what was recommended by the division. A breakdown of the proposed fees is enclosed, as well as located on the Board's web page at

http://commerce.alaska.gov/dnn/cbpl/ProfessionalLicensing/BoardofDentalExaminers.aspx. You may have received a copy of proposed fees in the last few weeks. That version did not reflect the Board's changes, so please see the attachment for the correct notice.

This fee proposal will enter a public comment period this week. The division encourages all licensees and interested parties to comment on this proposal through the division's Regulations Specialist, whose contact information is enclosed on the public notice. After the comment period closes and the division reviews all comments received, the division may adopt the regulation as drafted, may amend a proposed fee, or may withdraw the regulations in part or in its whole.

All comments received will be reviewed and taken into consideration prior to adopting the final regulations. The final decision will result in the fee to be implemented during this winter's license renewal.

## SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to change occupational license fees charged to dentists and dental hygienists.

The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 12, Chapter 02 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with occupational licensing fees related to the Board of Dental Examiners, including the following:

**12 AAC 02.190, Board of Dental Examiners,** is proposed to be changed to alter the application, license, renewal, permit, review, endorsement, and continuing education course submittal and resubmittal fees for dentists and dental hygienists, and also to repeal obsolete fees.

This is a **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE** adding to the **NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES** that was issued on September 23, 2014 concerning these proposed regulation revisions contained in the Department of Law file number JU2014200755. This **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE** is being issued because under the initial **NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES** the document containing the proposed regulation changes dealing with application, review, permit, continuing education course submittal and resubmittal fees for dentists and dental hygienists inadvertently omitted some proposed fee changes and contained some incorrect proposed fee changes. Therefore, the department is adding these corrected fee provisions and extending the written comment period in order to give interested persons an opportunity to comment on these corrected proposed regulation changes. If you previously submitted written comment under the September 23, 2014 **NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES**, you need not resubmit those comments under this notice as those comments are part of the record and will be considered by the department.

Under AS 08.01.065, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development must establish fee levels so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development has reviewed the income and expenses for the occupational licensing program for the Board of Dental Examiners and proposes fee changes that reflect, to the extent possible, the actual costs of the activities related to the program.

After the public comment period ends, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development will either adopt these or other provisions dealing with the same subject, without further notice, or decide to take no action on them. The language of the final regulations may be different from that of the proposed regulations. YOU SHOULD COMMENT DURING THE TIME ALLOWED IF YOUR INTERESTS COULD BE AFFECTED. Written comments received are public records and are subject to public inspection.

For each occupation regulated under the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing, the Division keeps a list of individuals or organizations who are interested in the regulations of that occupation. The Division automatically sends a Notice of Proposed Regulations to the parties on the appropriate list each time there is a proposed change in an occupation's regulations in Title 12 of the Alaska Administrative Code. If you would like your address added to or removed from such a list, please send your request to the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing at the address above and include your name, address, and the occupational area in which you are interested.
