151	Create a Migratory bird log book and end of year questionnaire for all migratory bird hunting guides.	1 – 7 – 0 Oppose Comments: We are opposed to this as written; it is too restrictive and a lot of the data requested by this proposal would be unattainable. A generic log book would be more reasonable for a guide in the field to deal with when looking after the safety of his clients. We are also looking at the fact that none of these proposals were generated by the Department. We think the Department is managing the resource on a sustainable level.

152	Redefine “edible meat” as it pertains to waterfowl so that more than breast meat is considered edible.	0 – 8 – 0 Oppose Comments: Unnecessary
153	Redefine “hindquarter” to include reference to wildfowl.	0 – 6 – 2 Oppose Comments: As with proposal 152 this is unnecessary
154	Redefine "trophy" to include wildfowl and meat of trophy must be salvaged.	0 – 8 – 0 Oppose Comments: Unnecessary
155	Redefine "possession limit" for migratory birds to establish seasonal bag limits for all species instead of daily bag limits.	0 – 8 – 0 Oppose Comments: This proposal would put the commercial guide out of business and we do not believe this would be the wishes of the Board. Hunters are just not going to spend that kind of money for day of hunting. Federal law already addresses this issue.
