ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO  
REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

The attached four pages of regulations, dealing with regulated New Source Review (NSR) pollutants are hereby adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Environmental Conservation adopts under the authority of AS 46.03 and AS 46.14 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.


Although no public comments were received, the Department of Environmental Conservation paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken. The Department of Environmental Conservation also gave special attention to alternate practical methods in this regulatory action, as required by AS 46.03.024.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor as provided in AS 44.62.180.

SUBJECT: 18 AAC 50, New Source Review (NSR)  
Pollutant Amendments

I have signed the adoption order for the above referenced changes to the Air Quality regulations and State Implementation Plan (SIP) dealing with New Source Review (NSR) pollutant standards. The Environmental Protection Agency changed the federal definitions of regulated NSR pollutant, in order to reflect the differences in the definitions for air quality attainment areas and nonattainment areas, such as in Fairbanks. DEC needs to adopt the new definition in order to have a New Source Review permitting program that accurately addresses precursor air emissions in nonattainment areas. There is no change in the burden on the regulated community as a result of this adoption. This is just a technical conforming change to satisfy the Environmental Protection Agency and does not change how the department implements the program.

A public hearing was tentatively scheduled to receive comments from the public, but the hearing was cancelled when no requests were received by the deadline.

We have reviewed the attached regulations from the Department of Environmental Conservation. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated October 10, 2014 from the Regulations Attorney. The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. To facilitate the prompt filing of those regulations that were ready the earliest, we have split this regulations project into two parts. This memorandum and the attached duplicate memorandum dated October 10, 2014 constitute the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The regulation changes were adopted by the Department of Environmental Conservation after the close of the public comment period. The regulations update provisions related to air quality and "new source review" (NSR) pollutants.

The adoption order for the regulations states that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

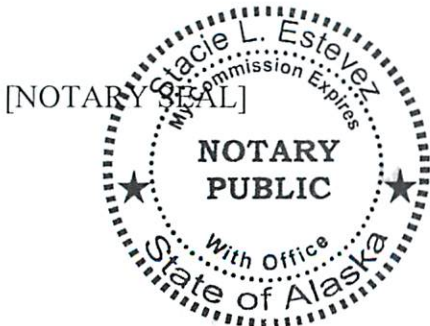

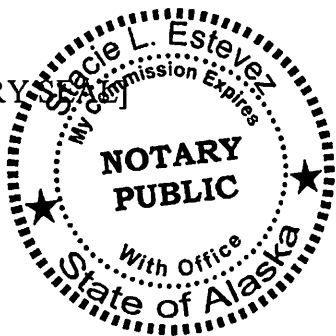

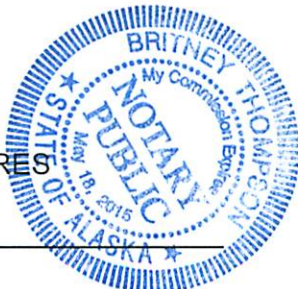

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) proposes changes to its air quality regulations, to adopt current U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) air quality regulations used in air quality control permits and EPA and Federal Highway Administration regulations needed to ensure that transportation projects funded by federal agencies protect air quality and conform to local air quality plans.

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 18, Chapter 50 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with air quality, the state air quality plan, air quality standards specific to the Mendenhall Valley area of Juneau, and conformity of federally funded transportation projects with air quality requirements and local air quality plans, including the following:

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## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) proposes changes to its air quality regulations, to adopt current U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) air quality regulations used in air quality control permits and EPA and Federal Highway Administration regulations needed to ensure that transportation projects funded by federal agencies protect air quality and conform to local air quality plans.

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 18, Chapter 50 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with air quality, the state air quality plan, air quality standards specific to the Mendenhall Valley area of Juneau, and conformity of federally funded transportation projects with air quality requirements and local air quality plans, including the following:

- **18 AAC 50.010(1)(A)** will be amended to include a cross-reference to an adopted test method.
- **18 AAC 50.015(b)(2)(A)** will be repealed and **18 AAC 50.015(e)** will be amended to re-designate the Mendenhall Valley Area of Juneau from "nonattainment" for coarse particulate matter (PM-10) to "attainment." These amendments reflect the fact that this area now meets the federal requirements for coarse particulates (PM10).
- **18 AAC 50.020** will be amended to establish the minor source baseline date for fine particulate matter (PM-2.5) in the Northern Alaska Intrastate Air Quality Control Region.
- **18 AAC 50.030** will be amended to adopt revisions to the State Air Quality Control Plan to address changes in federal regulations regarding the following topics: Conformity (Transportation and General), Clean Air Act Section 110 Infrastructure Certification (updated National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) and sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>)), and incorporating additional Appendix documents, including new regulations, and other documents that further support previously adopted plan revisions (Regional Haze Plan and Fairbanks Carbon Monoxide Limited Maintenance Plan).
- **18 AAC 50.035** and **18 AAC 50.215** will be amended to specify which quality assurance handbooks should be used when collecting meteorological data.
- **18 AAC 50.035** will be amended to reflect changes in Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.), Parts 50 (national primary and secondary ambient air quality standards), 58 (ambient air quality surveillance), 60 (standards of performance for new stationary sources), and 63 (national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants for source categories) and to adopt appendices of 40 C.F.R. Parts 58, 60, and 63 for use in monitoring and reference method testing actions.
- **18 AAC 50.040** will be amended to update the adoption by reference revision dates of 40 C.F.R. parts to adopt the most recent applicable requirements for operating permits.
- **18 AAC 50.040** will be amended to remove sections that are not required for states to adopt, and to reflect the adoption of the definition for "regulated NSR pollutant" in 40 C.F.R. 51.165(A)(1)(xxxvii).
- **18 AAC 50.215(d)** will be amended to revise language applicable to modeling demonstrations.
- **18 AAC 50.220(c)(1)(E)** and **18 AAC 50.220(c)(2)** will be amended to revise cross references to adopted-by-reference test methods in 18 AAC 50.035.
- **18 AAC 50.700 - 18 AAC 50.740 (Article 7)** will be amended to conform with the requirements of the federal 2005 Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) (Public Law 109-59). SAFETEA-LU eliminates the requirement for states to adopt and submit General Conformity State Implementation Plans.
- **18 AAC 50.990** (definitions) will be amended to add, clarify and modify definitions relevant to the overall proposal.
