FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Walker Mallott for Alaska, filed a complaint that alleges that Respondent, Republican Governors Association, violated AS 15.13 by failing to register prior to making expenditures and by failing to file independent expenditure reports.

The Staff conducted an investigation and prepared an investigation report recommending that the Complaint be dismissed. A hearing in this matter was held on January 24, 2019, in Anchorage, Alaska. APOC Staff presented the investigation report and Complainant made a statement.

After consideration of the investigation report and the evidence submitted with it, the Commission agrees with Staff's conclusion that the complaint should be dismissed due to a preponderance of the evidence showing that no violations occurred. Accordingly, the Complaint is dismissed.

This is a final Commission order. It may be appealed to superior court within 30 days from the date of this order under AS 44.62. A request for the Commission to reconsider this order must be filed within 15 days from the date this order is delivered or mailed pursuant to 2 AAC 50.891(g).
