



**ORDER OF THE ALASKA PUBLIC OFFICES COMMISSION**

**RESPONDENT:** Wilfred Fernandez, III  
**VIOLATION:** Late-Filed Final POFD Statement  
**MAXIMUM CIVIL PENALTY:** \$290  
**PENALTY ASSESSED:** \$145<sup>1</sup>  
**COMMISSION DECISION:** Reduce by 50% to \$72.50  
**REASON(S) FOR THE DECISION:**

After reviewing the facts in this case and mitigating factors under 2 AAC.50.865, the Commission found that the penalty for Respondent’s late-filed Final Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement should be reduced by 50%. This decision is based on applicable mitigating factors including the filer’s good filing history.
