**Cheryl Frasca**, individually, in her roles as a long term campaign treasurer having served on many campaigns over the decades. In this case, she serves a dual role as:

- Treasurer, Janelle Sharp Campaign, and
- “APOC Reporting Administrator”, Independent Expenditure Group Friends of the Good Guys

**III. JURISDICTION**

This complaint is filed with the Alaska Public Offices Commission pursuant to Alaska Statutes Chapter 15.13 and 2 AAC 50.

**IV. SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS**

This complaint alleges multiple violations of Alaska campaign finance law arising from several interrelated compliance failures. Specifically, the independent expenditure group and certain donors failed to timely report large contributions as required by law. The filings further reflect incomplete or inaccurate reporting information, undermining the transparency required under Alaska’s campaign finance framework. Finally, political advertising associated with these activities contains deficient disclosures that do not meet statutory requirements, including those set forth in AS 15.13.135. In addition, there exists a structural overlap between the candidate campaign and the independent expenditure group that raises substantial concerns regarding coordination between the candidate and the Independent Expenditure Group.

Taken together, these violations demonstrate both compliance failures and a credible risk that the independence requirement has been compromised.

#### **IV. KEY VIOLATIONS**

- A. Campaign failure to report 24-hour contributions
- B. Donor failure to report 24-hour contributions (Justin Creech, Colby Kelly)
- C. Defective disclaimer that failed to certify independence from candidate (AS 15.13.135)
- D. Structural coordination risk via shared agent (Cheryl Frasca)

#### **V. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

1. The independent expenditure group (ID 6903) failed to report two contributions exceeding \$2,000 within the required 24-hour reporting period, as required under Alaska law.
2. Two donors associated with the above contributions also failed to report two contributions exceeding \$2,000 within the required 24-hour reporting period, as required under Alaska law. (Justin Creech and Colby Kelly)
3. Political mailers distributed by or on behalf of the IE group contain deficient “Paid for by” (PFB) disclaimers, including failure to include the statutorily required language certifying there was no coordination with the candidate:

*“This NOTICE TO VOTERS is required by Alaska law. (I/we) certify that this (mailing/literature/advertisement) is not authorized, paid for, or approved by the candidate.” (Emphasis added)*

4. Cheryl Frasca simultaneously serves as Treasurer for the Janelle Sharp Campaign (ID 7900) beneficiary of the independent expenditure; and “APOC Reporting Administrator” for Friends of the Good Guys (ID 6903), the funder of the independent expenditure; and has access to non-public campaign information from both entities.

#### **VI. ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF LAW AND MATTERS REQUIRING INVESTIGATION**

##### **A. Failure to Timely Report Contributions (AS 15.13 Reporting Requirements)**

Alaska law requires that contributions exceeding specified thresholds, including those over \$2,000, be reported within 24 hours to ensure timely transparency during an active election. Both the IE group and certain donors failed to comply with Alaska Stat. § 15.13.040(r)(3) and Alaska Stat. § 15.13.110(k).

A.1: The independent expenditure group failed to report such contributions within the required timeframe under Alaska law.

A.2: The associated donors likewise failed to file the reports required of them under law.

Cheryl Frasca submitted a report for entity 6903 on 3/30/2026 that reported several contributions by individual donors between 3/11/2026 and 3/12/2026. Two of the donations reported by Frasca were in excess of \$2,000. She reported that Colby Kelly donated \$3,000 on 3/11/2026 and that Justin Creech donated \$5,000 on 3/12/2026. Alaska Statutes AS 15.13.040(r)(3) and AS 15.13.110(k) require reporting by both the campaign and the donor of contributions in excess of \$2,000.

These constitute independent reporting violations. The failure is particularly significant because it allowed the independent expenditure group to operate without timely public disclosure for an extended period, including during the critical final weeks of the election, when properly reported transactions would have alerted the public to substantial financial activity by the IE group. This delay undermines the core purpose of Alaska’s campaign finance laws, which is to provide voters with near real-time visibility into the sources and beneficiaries of political spending, especially large contributions.

### **B. Defective Political Communication Disclaimers (AS 15.13.135)**

Political communications must include specific disclaimer language. Entity 6903 failed to include the required “NOTICE TO VOTERS” language in at least two of three mailers it has put out. Not being in possession of the third reported mailer it is difficult to conclude whether the language was included there. But in any case, the omission renders the mailers included in this complaint **noncompliant with AS 15.13.135**. The Commission should secure the third mailer to confirm.

Political communications are required to include specific disclaimer language to ensure transparency and inform voters about the source and independence of the message. The omission of the required “NOTICE TO VOTERS” language undermines this statutory purpose and renders the mailers noncompliant with AS 15.13.135. Such omissions create a risk that voters are misled regarding whether the communication was authorized or coordinated with a candidate, and therefore warrant scrutiny and enforcement by APOC.

In this case, the omission is particularly significant as it is the language in which the entity certifies there has been no coordination with the candidates’ campaigns. With no certification, it adds to the Prima facie evidence of coordination detailed next.

### **C. Potential Illegal Coordination**

Under AS 15.13, independent expenditures must be made “without consultation, cooperation, or prior consent of the candidate or campaign.” It is highly suspect that this is even possible considering the dual roles filled by Cheryl Frasca.

Cheryl Frasca has decades of campaign experience and is a veteran of dozens of candidate campaigns and independent expenditure groups. In fact, there are more than 200 reports filed by her. In this case, Ms. Frasca is playing on both sides of the fence. She is operating the treasury of a candidate campaign and she is acting as an administrator of an independent expenditure group supporting that same candidate.

The dual role of Ms. Frasca creates a **common agent scenario**, establishing:

- A pathway for transfer of non-public information, and
- A credible risk of coordination

This is particularly significant given:

- The reporting irregularities
- The failure to certify the independence of the expenditure on publications, and
- The timing-sensitive nature of IE expenditures

Ms. Frasca's simultaneous roles as campaign treasurer and "APOC reporting administrator" for the independent expenditure group creates a structural overlap that directly implicates the requirement of independence under Alaska law. The dual roles constitute Prima facie evidence of coordination. The burden shifts to the Independent Expenditure to demonstrate a firewall between the candidate and the IE group.

In her role as treasurer, she has access to non-public campaign information, including financial planning and strategic timing decisions. At the same time, her position within the independent expenditure group places her within its reporting and operational processes also with access to parallel non-public information. This dual role creates a credible pathway for the transfer or use of non-public campaign information in connection with purportedly independent expenditures, raising substantial concerns that the required legal separation between the campaign and the independent expenditure group has not been maintained.

It is argued that it is impossible for the campaign and independent expenditure group to be actually independent from each other when they share the same staff and consultants. Given the nature of these overlapping responsibilities, it is difficult to identify a scenario in which no coordination risk exists.

This is precisely the type of arrangement that warrants close scrutiny, as it goes to the core of transparency and compliance in Alaska's campaign finance system. These concerns are further heightened by the failure to include the required certification of non-coordination on printed political materials, as mandated by law, which reinforces the need for investigation into whether the independence requirement has been compromised. APOC should make direct inquiries with both entities and sort through what firewalls may exist or not.

#### **D. Violations of 2 AAC 50.250–.405 (Coordination Regulations)**

Alaska Administrative Code 2 AAC 50.250–.405 governs when expenditures reported as "independent" are deemed coordinated with a candidate or campaign. Under these provisions, expenditures are not independent where they are made in cooperation, consultation, or concert with a candidate or their agents, including through the involvement of a common agent or the use of material, nonpublic information.

The facts set forth herein establish sufficient evidence to warrant a finding that the expenditures reported by Friends of the Good Guys may not qualify as independent expenditures under these regulations.

### **1. Common Agent Relationship**

Cheryl Frasca serves simultaneously as Treasurer for the Janelle Sharp Campaign and as “APOC Reporting Administrator” for Friends of the Good Guys. This dual role constitutes a common agent relationship between the candidate committee and the independent expenditure group. Under 2 AAC 50.250–.405, the involvement of a common agent is a significant indicator of coordination and, absent clear and effective safeguards, is sufficient to overcome the presumption of independence. The same individual holding operational responsibilities within both entities creates a direct channel through which information and strategic alignment may occur.

### **2. Material, Nonpublic Information**

As campaign treasurer, Ms. Frasca has access to material, nonpublic information, including but not limited to campaign financial status, anticipated expenditures, and strategic timing considerations. Her concurrent role with the independent expenditure group provides the opportunity to use or convey such information in connection with that group’s activities. The availability and potential use of material, nonpublic information in connection with purported independent expenditures is prohibited under 2 AAC 50.250–.405 and is incompatible with the statutory requirement of independence.

### **3. Absence of Demonstrated Firewall or Mitigation Measures**

There is no evidence in the public record that any firewall, recusal protocol, or other internal control exists to prevent the transfer or use of nonpublic information between the campaign and the independent expenditure group. In the presence of a common agent, the absence of such safeguards is highly probative of coordination.

Where no effective separation mechanisms are demonstrated, APOC precedent supports a finding that the independence requirement has not been satisfied.

### **4. Effect on Legal Status of Expenditures**

Given (i) the existence of a common agent, (ii) access to material, nonpublic information, and (iii) the absence of any demonstrated safeguards, there is a substantial basis to conclude that the expenditures reported by Friends of the Good Guys may have been made in coordination with the Janelle Sharp Campaign.

If so, such expenditures do not qualify as independent expenditures under Alaska law and must be treated as coordinated expenditures, subject to applicable contribution limits, reporting requirements, and prohibitions under AS 15.13.

### **5. Need for Investigation and Burden Clarification**

The determination of coordination is inherently fact-specific and requires access to information not available in public filings, including communications, internal policies, and the timing and flow of information between the entities.

Accordingly, once a prima facie showing of a common agent and access to nonpublic information has been established, the burden shifts to the respondents to demonstrate that adequate firewalls or other measures were in place to preserve independence.

APOC should therefore compel production of relevant records and testimony sufficient to determine whether the regulatory requirements of 2 AAC 50.250–.405 have been satisfied.

## VII. BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION

The facts described above establish both multiple independent statutory violations and a structural relationship between the campaign and the independent expenditure group that warrants investigation into potential coordination. Determining whether coordination has occurred is inherently fact-intensive and depends on information not available in public filings, including internal communications, the timing of knowledge, and the functional roles of individuals involved. As a result, APOC must utilize its investigative authority to examine these underlying facts and determine whether non-public campaign information influenced the independent expenditure activity and whether the legal requirement of independence has been violated.

## VIII. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

The Complainant respectfully requests that the Alaska Public Offices Commission:

1. **Initiate a formal investigation** into all violations described herein;
2. **Request key I.E. and Campaign records, and Issue subpoenas** if needed for:
  - Communications involving Cheryl Frasca, the campaign, and the IE group
  - Records related to the unreported contributions
  - Internal IE and campaign planning documents
  - Establish if any clear written firewall policy exists between Campaign and IE.
3. **Take sworn testimony** from relevant individuals;
4. Determine whether:
  - Reporting violations occurred
  - Disclaimer violations occurred
  - Independent expenditures were in fact coordinated
5. Impose appropriate remedies and penalties under AS 15.13. It is notable that since both candidate and independent expenditure groups have engaged with one of the most prolific APOC Campaign Treasurer/Administrators in Alaska history, no reduction is warranted for first time filers.

## IX. CONCLUSION

This complaint presents allegations of clear reporting violations and defective campaign disclosures and relationships that establish the appearance of coordination between the candidate campaign and the independent expenditure group.

These issues, taken together, warrant **prompt and thorough investigation** to ensure compliance with Alaska campaign finance law and to preserve public confidence in the electoral process.

**Zac voted against Civilian Police Oversight**, despite eight officer-involved shootings resulting in death that year; including one that led to a settlement exceeding \$2 million. He also voted against requiring accountability measures tied to police-worn body cameras.


**Zac opposes Affordable Housing**. Zac has become the Assembly's most consistent vote against efforts to make housing more affordable and attainable for ordinary people. Zac serves the wealthy and powerful, while pulling the ladder up on Anchorage's next generation. High housing costs hurt Anchorage's economy, force workers to move away, and are a direct contributor to high rates of housing insecurity and homelessness.

**Zac supports Punishing the Unhoused**. Instead of addressing root causes, Zac advocates for enforcement-first approaches that criminalize and punish the vulnerable. Zac's approach simply moves homeless residents around, all while refusing to address the root causes (such as housing costs) that drive homelessness.
