

STIPULATION

The parties stipulate as follows:

1. On October 29, 2010, the Alaska State Medical Board adopted a new policy relating to sanctions for technical violations not related to the delivery of health care. The sanctions in the new policy are different than the sanctions the Board imposed on Dr. Sykes and from which Dr. Sykes appealed.

2. Dr. Sykes wishes to ask the Board to modify the sanction it imposed on him by applying its new policy to the violations with which he was charged.

3. If the Board modifies the sanctions by applying its new policy to Dr. Sykes' violations, then this appeal will be moot.

4. The parties agree to the stay of this appeal and to its remand to the Alaska State Medical Board so that Dr. Sykes may request that the Board consider whether to

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
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
modify the sanctions it imposed and so that the Board may determine whether to modify the sanctions.
