## DECISION

### **I. Introduction**

L. K. timely applied for a 2007 permanent fund dividend. The Permanent Fund Dividend Division determined that Ms. K. was not eligible, and it denied the application initially and at the informal appeal level. Ms. K. requested a formal hearing. Administrative Law Judge Dale Whitney heard the appeal on June 9, 2008. Because she registered to vote in another state during the qualifying year, Ms. K. does not qualify for a 2006 dividend.

#### **II.** Facts

In 2006, the qualifying year for a 2007 dividend, Ms. K. was out of Alaska attending the University of Pittsburgh. The division does not dispute that Ms. K. has remained an Alaska resident, and that her absence was allowable for the purpose of receiving postsecondary education on a full-time basis.

On October 24, 2006, Ms. K. was approached by a person on campus who was registering people to vote. Ms. K. filled out a voter registration form, and the State of Pennsylvania sent her a voter identification card. Ms. K. later removed herself from Pennsylvania's voter rolls and registered to vote in Alaska. At the time she registered in Pennsylvania, Ms. K. did not know that she could register in Alaska and vote absentee.

#### **III.** Discussion

The following law, 15 AAC 23.143(d), applies to this case:

An individual is not eligible for a dividend if, at any time from January 1 of the qualifying year through the date of application, the individual has...(12) registered to vote in another state or country, except if the individual

(A) registered to vote in another state within 30 days of a presidential election solely for the purpose of voting in that election and voted in no other election in another state that that for president of the United States; or

(B) registered to vote in another country for which the individual was not required to claim residency of the country in order to register to vote....

There is no dispute that Ms. K. did register to vote in Pennsylvania during 2006, the qualifying year for a 2007 dividend. Ms. K. did not register within 30 days of an election.

## **IV. Conclusion**

In spite of the fact that Ms. K. has remained an Alaska resident and was allowably absent, she is not eligible for a 2007 dividend. The division's decision is AFFIRMED. Because she has remained an Alaska resident, nothing in this decision is intended to affect Ms. K.'s eligibility for 2008 and subsequent dividends.
