Notice is given that The Department of Administration, under the authority of AS 47.55.030, proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 2 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with the monthly rate charged a Pioneers' Homes resident, to amend 2 AAC 41.015, to raise the rates for the Alaska Pioneers' Homes.

This revision will replace the fiscal year 2000 rates with new ones for fiscal year 2001, continuing the steps towards a rate schedule providing for payment of the full cost of care by fiscal year 2003. This change implements a recommendation of the Pioneers' Homes Advisory board made in the fall of 1995, and is reflected in the Governor's proposed budget for FY 2001.

Notice is also given that any person interested may present written comments relevant to the proposed action, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed action, by writing to James L. Kohn, Director, Division of Alaska Longevity Programs, Department of Administration, PO Box 110211, Juneau AK 99811-0211. Written comments must be received no later than April 27, 2000.

Additionally, any interested person may present oral or written comments relevant to the proposed action, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed action, at a hearing to be held in the Department of Administration's Conference Room on the 10th floor of the State Office Building, Juneau Alaska, April 7, 2000. The other teleconference sites for the April 7th hearing will be at each Pioneers' Home. The homes are located in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau, Ketchikan, Palmer and Sitka. A person may present his or her statements or arguments at any of the seven teleconference sites.

The hearing will be held from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and might be extended to accommodate those present before noon who have not had an opportunity to testify.

This action will not require an increased appropriation.
