ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The attached six pages of regulations, dealing with licensing and practice of athletic trainers, are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development adopts under the authority of AS 08.01.010, AS 08.01.065, AS 08.01.100, AS 08.07.010, AS 08.07.020, AS 08.07.030, AS 08.07.040, and AS 08.07.090 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

100. Application for athletic trainer license

12 AAC 78.100. Application for athletic trainer license. An applicant for licensure as an athletic trainer must submit

- (1) a completed application on a form provided by the department;
- (2) the applicable fees established in 12 AAC 02.395;
- (3) proof of the applicant's certification as an athletic trainer as required in AS 08.07.020, sent directly to the department from
 - (A) the Board of Certification, Inc.; or
 - (B) another nationally recognized professional association approved by the department; and
- (4) verification of the applicant's licensure status sent directly to the department from each jurisdiction where the applicant is or was previously licensed to practice athletic training; each verification must include
 - (A) an explanation of any disciplinary actions taken against the licensee;
 - (B) documentation of
 - (i) any violation of the *BOC Standards of Professional Practice*, adopted by reference in 12 AAC 78.300(b); and

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(ii) any conviction, unresolved pending action, or adverse decision based upon a complaint, investigation, review procedure, or other disciplinary proceeding that the jurisdiction or a federal or state law enforcement agency undertakes, that relates to the applicant's criminal or fraudulent activity, malpractice, or negligent care, and that adversely reflects on the applicant's ability or competence to practice athletic training. 12 AAC 78.200. License renewal. (a) An individual must renew an athletic trainer license biennially on or before August 31 of odd-numbered years. The department will furnish a renewal reminder to each currently licensed athletic trainer at least 30 days before the renewal date at the address and in the manner that the licensee requests. Failure to receive a renewal reminder does not relieve a licensee from the responsibility of renewing a license on time.

- (b) An applicant for renewal of an athletic trainer license must
 - (1) complete the renewal application on a form provided by the department;

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- (2) pay the license renewal fee established in 12 AAC 02.395; and
- (3) provide proof of the applicant's certification as an athletic trainer as required in AS 08.07.020, sent directly to the department from
 - (A) the Board of Certification, Inc.; or
 - (B) another nationally recognized professional association approved by the department.

300. Athletic trainer standards

12 AAC 78.300. Athletic trainer standards. (a) While engaging in athletic training, an individual licensed under AS 08.07.020 shall display or carry proof of the licensee's current

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- (b) An individual licensed under AS 08.07.020 shall comply with the ethical standards in the Board of Certification, Inc.'s *BOC Standards of Professional Practice*, dated January 1, 2006 and adopted by reference.
- (c) An individual licensed under AS 08.07.020 or an individual licensed to practice medicine or osteopathy under AS 08.64 may supervise at the same time not more than five student athletic trainers described in AS 08.07.010(a)(1).
- (d) An individual licensed under AS 08.07.020 shall inform the department not later than 30 days after any disciplinary action taken by the Board of Certification, Inc., by another nationally recognized professional association approved by the department, or by any jurisdiction in which the individual holds a license to practice athletic training. If the licensee fails to provide timely notification in accordance with this subsection, the department may impose disciplinary action, including probation, suspension of the individual's license, or revocation of the individual's license.
