ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO
REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE,
COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The attached one page of regulations, dealing with occupational licensing fees related to the Board of Massage Therapists, is adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development adopts under the authority of AS 08.01.010, AS 08.01.065, and AS 08.61.090 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

In considering public comments, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.

Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02 is amended by adding a new section to Article 2 to read:

12 AAC 02.396. Board of Massage Therapists. The following fees are established for massage therapists:

- (1) nonrefundable application fee for initial license, \$200;
- (2) massage therapy license fee for all or part of the initial biennial licensing period, \$350;
- (3) massage therapy biennial license renewal fee, \$350;
- (4) nonrefundable fingerprint processing fee, \$60. (Eff. 8 / 1 / 2015,
