IN SUPPORT OF A COMMERCIAL TIMBER HARVEST OPERATION, STC WILL INSTALL AN AIRPLANE FLOAT AND RAMP, LOG RAFT STORAGE AREAS WITH STIFF LEGS, BUOYS AND ANCHORS, AND A TWO-POINT SHIP MOORING SYSTEM WITH ANCHORS AND BUOYS. THERE WILL ALSO BE A DRIVE-DOWN LTF RAMP FOR PLACING LOG BUNDLES INTO THE WATER (MCKENZIE INLET).

AS IN ALL LOGGING OPERATIONS, #2 DIESEL IS THE PRIMARY HAZARDOUS MATERIAL THAT WILL BE TRANSPORTED AND STORED ON SITE, WITH GASOLINE A SECONDARY COMPONENT. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT DURING THE COURSE OF AN EIGHT YEAR OPERATION, OUR CONTRACTOR WILL CONSUME APPROXIMATELY 800,000 GALLONS OF DIESEL AND AN ADDITIONAL 120,000 GALLONS OF GASOLINE. THERE WILL ALSO BE A VERY MINOR AMOUNT OF VARIOUS LUBE OILS AND GREASES INVOLVED.
