(Repsol), dated September 25, 2015, to conduct exploration drilling at two locations within the Pikka Unit in the Colville River Delta area. Repsol requests authorization to conduct exploration drilling at two locations in the Colville River Delta area. One exploration drill site will be located on an island within the Colville River Delta and the other will be located on uplands approximately 0.6 miles east of the delta. Temporary ice roads will be used to access the drill sites and drilling will occur on temporary ice pads, each with a surface area of approximately 5.7 acres.
