SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska  
Administrative Code (AAC):  
7 AAC 130.300(c) and (d)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are 7 AAC 130.300(c) and (d), as they appear in the supplement pamphlet for January 2016 (Register 216) and in the electronic FOLIO database. The errors do *not* appear in the main pamphlet published in January 2015 (Register 212), and the agency has not amended 7 AAC 130.300(c) and (d) since that time. The revisions to those subsections are as follows:

--Reposition what is displayed as 7 AAC 130.300(c)(1) and (2) so that the two paragraphs follow 7 AAC 130.300(d) rather than 7 AAC 130.300(c).

The above changes are necessary because when printing the supplement pamphlet for Title 7 (Health and Social Services), the publisher incorrectly positioned what should be 7 AAC 130.300(d)(1) and (2), so that those paragraphs inaccurately follow 7 AAC 130.300(c) rather than the introductory language for 7 AAC 130.300(d). Again, the error appears only in the gray supplement pamphlet and the electronic FOLIO database, not the red main pamphlet.
