SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
17 AAC 45.990

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the revisions to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these revisions under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions re-arrange the order of paragraphs within a section to conform to a more logical arrangement of subject matter.

The regulations to be revised are the definitions in 17 AAC 45.990, including definitions that were added, amended, or repealed as part of regulations filed February 19, 2016 and that will take effect March 20, 2016 (Department of Law file number JU2015200748). Please re-arrange all the definitions in 17 AAC 45.990 so that they are in alphabetical order. Delete paragraphs that consist only of "repealed" notations. In addition, after 17 AAC 45.990, add an editor's note to read as follows:

Editor's note: As of Register 217 (April 2016), the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b)(6) reorganized definitions in 17 AAC 45.990 to put them in alphabetical order, regardless of when each of them was adopted.
