 - Pre-service (orientation) training costs. Currently, this is estimated to be \$247.50 per person through Alaska's statewide Child Care Resource and Referral Network (CCR&R). The Child Care Program Office is working with CCR&R to further develop this training at the most reasonable cost.
 - o <u>Proposed regulation revisions to 7 AAC 41.205(c)(1), background check</u> requirements for any individual in the household, will be lowered from at least 18 years of age to at least 16 years of age. This cost is \$20 per person.
