AMENDED ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS
OF THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC ADVOCACY

The attached 4 pages of regulations, dealing with increases in fees charged to wards of the Public Guardian are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Office of Public Advocacy adopts under the authority of AS 44.21.410(b)(1) and 13.26.410 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.



2 AAC 60.080(a) is amended to read:

(a) The OPA shall charge a case opening fee for establishment of a guardianship or conservatorship case, including a fee for any reappointments for the same client if the reappointment is made more than three months after the termination of a prior appointment. The case opening fee shall be

- (1) **\$200** [\$100] if OPA serves as guardian;
- (2) **\$300** [\$200] if OPA serves as conservator; and
- (3) **\$500** [\$300] if OPA serves as combined guardian and conservator.

2 AAC 60.080(b) is amended to read:

(b) Except as provided in 2 AAC 60.100(f), OPA shall charge a monthly fee for guardianship and conservatorship services provided to a client during the previous month. The OPA shall charge **\$85** [\$40] per month for guardian services. The OPA shall determine a fee for conservator services, or combined guardian and conservator services, based upon the highest value of a client's liquid assets during each month that services are provided, by using the sliding scale fee schedule set out in 2 AAC 60.110(a).

We have reviewed the attached regulations from the Department of Administration against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated May 24, 2016 from the Regulations Attorney. The regulations adjust fees that the Office of Public Advocacy charges to wards of the public guardian for guardianship services, conservatorship services, or both guardianship and conservatorship services.

We find no legal problems. Though the supporting paperwork for these regulations describes them as "Office of Public Advocacy" regulations rather than department regulations under AS 13.26.410(a) and AS 44.21.410(b)(1), the commissioner of administration has issued a limited delegation of authority to the director of the Office of Public Advocacy to adopt these regulations. We also note that though the May 19, 2016 adoption order has the word "amended" in the title, the order refers to regulations that have been technically reformatted according to the Department of Law *Drafting Manual for Administrative Regulations* (Aug. 2015). The May 19, 2016 reformatted regulations do not vary substantively from regulations adopted under a superseded adoption order of May 17, 2016. Under these circumstances, we do not find a substantive violation of the Administrative Procedure Act.

This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. We note that the adoption order identifies a special effective date of July 1, 2016 for these regulations.

The April 16, 2016 public notice and the May 19, 2016 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

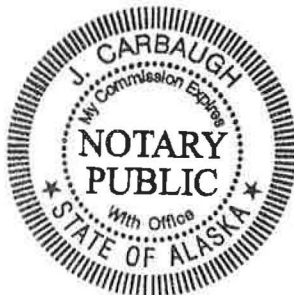

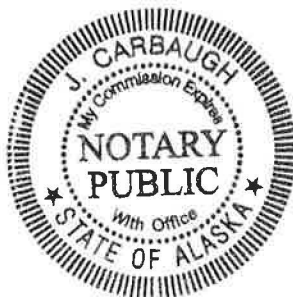

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO PUBLIC GUARDIAN FEE SCHEDULE

IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC ADVOCACY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Office of Public Advocacy proposes to change regulations regarding Public Guardian fees charged to wards for Guardian and Conservatorship services.

The Office of Public Advocacy proposes to adopt regulation changes in Establishment of Fees and Fee Schedule of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with an increase in fees charged to wards for services provided including the following:

(1) 2 AAC 60.080 is proposed to be changed as follows: Case opening fees for guardianship services increased from \$100 to \$200; Case opening fees for conservator services increased from \$200 to \$300; Case opening fees for combined guardianship and conservatorship services increased from \$300 to \$500 and monthly fees for guardianship and conservatorship services increased from \$40 per month to \$85 per month.

(2) 2 AAC 60.110, is proposed to be changed as follows: Increase the monthly fee for each category of value of client's liquid Assets by \$45 and increase the annual property management fees and property sale fees by 100%.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to Chad W. Holt, Deputy Director, Office of Public Advocacy, 900 West 5th Avenue, suite 525, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. Additionally, the Office of Public Advocacy will accept comments by electronic mail at chad.holt@alaska.gov. The comments must be received not later than 5:00pm on May 16, 2016.

You may submit written questions relevant to the proposed action to Chad W. Holt, Deputy Director, Office of Public Advocacy, 900 West 5th Avenue, Suite 525, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The Office of Public Advocacy will aggregate its response to substantially similar

questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and agency website.
