The attached two pages of regulations, dealing with occupational licensing fees for audiologists, hearing aid dealers, speech-language pathologists, and speech-language pathologist assistants, are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development adopts under the authority of AS 08.01.065, AS 08.11.010, AS 08.11.020, AS 08.11.050, AS 08.55.010, and AS 08.55.040 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.


This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.



Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02.130 is amended to read:

12 AAC 02.130. Audiologists, hearing aid dealers, speech-language pathologists, and speech-language pathologist assistants. The following fees are established for audiologists, hearing aid dealers, speech-language pathologists, and speech-language pathologist assistants:

- (1) application fee for initial license or registration, **\$150** [\$50];
- (2) temporary license fee for audiologists or speech-language pathologists, **\$100** [\$25];
- (3) audiologist or speech-language pathologist license fee for all or part of the initial biennial license period, **\$150** [\$25];
- (4) biennial audiologist or speech-language pathologist license renewal fee, **\$150** [\$25];
- (5) hearing aid dealer license fee for all or part of the initial biennial license period, **\$150** [\$100];
- (6) hearing aid dealer biennial license renewal fee, **\$150** [\$100];
- (7) delinquent fee for delayed renewal, \$50;
- (8) speech-language pathologist assistant registration fee for all or part of the initial biennial registration period, **\$100** [\$25];
- (9) biennial speech-language pathologist assistant registration renewal fee, **\$100** [\$25].
