(7) delinquent fee for delayed renewal, \$50;

(8) speech-language pathologist assistant registration fee for all or part of the

initial biennial registration period, **§100** [\$25];

(9) biennial speech-language pathologist assistant registration renewal fee, <u>\$100</u>
