The following question was posed by a vendor. The answers follow the questions.

1. **Q:** Page 17 of the ITB states:

Required Bid Documents:

1. Completed and Signed Page #1.
2. Completed Bid Schedule Pages #16-17
3. All applicable Mandatory Return Amendments.

Are there other items which must be included as part of the Bid Documents?

A: *Yes. The ITB states on Page 12: "The Contractor shall be responsible for providing safe and suitable berthing for the vessel during the entire lay-up period."
The Bid Documents must include the details as to how you will provide this "safe and suitable berthing". The Bid Documents must clearly state how the prospective Contractor will meet the responsibilities as mentioned on Page 9, under "Continuing Obligation of Contractor".*

It must also address all aspects of the General and Detailed Scopes of Work. Which includes the "Security and Monitoring Plan" mentioned on Page 12 and under Scope Item No. 3 – In-Water Berthing all "dimensions", "arrangements" and "supporting calculations" required in the "In-Water Berthing" paragraph on Page 14.
