



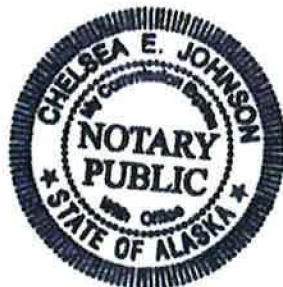

The emergency adoption of 7 AAC 145.012 is made permanent to read:

7 AAC 145.012. Cost containment measure for inflation adjustments to Medicaid payment rates. (a) To address that appropriations for fiscal year 2017 [2016] are insufficient to cover the costs of medical assistance for all persons eligible under AS 47.07 and 7 AAC 100, the department will implement cost containment measures that prohibit the following adjustments to Medicaid payment rates for Medicaid claims with dates of services after June 30, 2016, [2015,] and before July 1, 2017 [2016]:

- (1) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 145.050(b)(3);
- (2) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 145.265(b)(9);
- (3) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 145.500(b) as that subsection relates to 7 AAC 145.520(g)(1); *← (Publisher: These cross-references are correct as set out in this draft, but in the print version of the Alaska Administrative Code and in the electronic database, the numeral "1" is incorrectly set out as the letter "l"; please correct the manifest errors.))*
- (4) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 145.520(g)(1);
- (5) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 145.700;
- (6) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 150.150;
- (7) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 150.160(h) as that subsection relates to 7 AAC 150.150; and
- (8) inflation adjustments required under 7 AAC 150.190(g) in accordance with 7 AAC 150.190(d)(2)(B).

(b) In this section, "inflation adjustment" means a revision that

(1) is required under a provision listed in (a)(1) - (8) of this section to an existing Medicaid payment rate; and

(2) results in a new Medicaid payment rate that differs from the existing Medicaid payment rate by a percentage value or overall average net change value that is either listed under this chapter or listed in

(A) the most recent annual *Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U)*, all items, for Anchorage, Alaska published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, adopted by reference in 7 AAC 160.900;

(B) the Global Insight's *Healthcare Cost Review*; or

(C) the Medicare Economic Index as required by 42 U.S.C. 7/1/2015, Register 215, am
1396a(bb)(3)(A), adopted by reference in 7 AAC 160.900. (Eff. 7/1/2016, Register 219)

Editor's note: The provisions [EMERGENCY ADOPTION] of 7 AAC 145.012 were first adopted as emergency regulations with an effective date of July 1, 2015. Those emergency regulations were [15] made permanent [EFFECTIVE AUGUST 14, 2015]. The July 1, 2016 amendments to 7 AAC 145.012 took effect as emergency regulations to be made permanent. In reviewing the permanent amendments in accordance with AS 44.62.060 and 44.62.125(b), the regulations attorney requested that the publisher correct two unrelated manifest errors in 7 AAC 145.012(a), as that subsection appeared in print in the Alaska Administrative Code. The technical changes to correct the manifest errors appear in 7 AAC 145.012(a) as published in Register 219. 2
(October 2016). The history note for 7 AAC 145.012 does not reflect the corrections requested by the regulations attorney.

We have reviewed the attached emergency regulations from the Department of Health and Social Services against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated August 3, 2016 from the Regulations Attorney. The department adopted the emergency regulations on June 21, 2016, your office filed them on June 21, 2016, they took effect July 1, 2016 under a special effective date set in the adoption order, and they expire October 28, 2016 unless they are made permanent. In response to reduced appropriations from the legislature, the regulations establish cost containment measures for inflation adjustments to Medicaid payment rates.

We find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations as permanent regulations.

The June 21, 2016 adoption order and the June 24, 2016 public notice both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to the lead-in line, history note, and editor's note for the regulations, in accordance with AS 44.62.125 and as shown on the attached copy. Also, in the revisor's capacity under AS 44.62.125, we have requested that the publisher correct two manifest printing errors in 7 AAC 145.012(a)(3) and (4), as those paragraphs appear in the Alaska Administrative Code. In those paragraphs, the cross-references to "7 AAC 145.520(g)(l)" should instead read 7 AAC 145.520(g)(1): i.e., the numeral "1" should replace the letter "l". The agency's attached copy sets out the cross-references correctly. We have included an explanatory editor's note in the attached copy.
