6. Appropriation/Allocation: Spill Prevention and Response Division, Underground Storage Tank Program

7. Estimated annual costs in the aggregate to comply with the proposed action to:

a. Private Persons: Persons seeking Underground Storage Tank Worker certification and/or certification renewal required for installation, testing and closure of Underground Storage Systems in the State of Alaska will experience an increase in the cost of existing certification fees. This increase is an additional \$25.00 to EACH of the following certification fees: Application Fee, Certification Fee(s) per Category, Renewal Certification Fee(s) per Category, and Reciprocity Certification Fee(s) per Category. Applicable fees are paid biennially on odd-numbered years to the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for occupational licensing functions and are established under AS 46.03.375(b). The number of certifications per individual ranges from 1-5 (meaning the additional certification costs per individual will range from \$25-\$125. Over the two-year fee period this results in a per-year increase ranging from \$12.50-\$62.50).
