12 AAC 02.145, Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives, is proposed to be changed to alter the application, certification, permit, and renewal fees for direct-entry midwives and apprentices.

Under AS 08.01.065, the Department must establish fee levels so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The Department has reviewed the income and expenses for the occupational licensing program for the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives and proposes fee changes that reflect, to the extent possible, the actual costs of the activities related to the program.

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
