Register 220, January 2017 PROFESSIONAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02.145 is amended to read:

12 AAC 02.145. Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives. The following fees are established for direct-entry midwives and apprentices:

(1) nonrefundable application fee for initial certification, **\$500** [\$250];

(2) certification fee for all or part of the initial biennial certification period,

<u>\$3,800</u> [\$1,750];

(3) biennial certification renewal fee, <u>\$3,800</u> [\$1,750];

(4) apprentice direct-entry midwife permit fee, <u>\$1,275</u> [\$825];

(5) biennial apprentice direct-entry midwife permit renewal fee, <u>\$1,275</u> [\$825];

(6) nonrefundable application fee for initial apprentice direct-entry midwife

permit, <u>\$250</u> [\$125].
