Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02.260 is amended to read:

12 AAC 02.260. Mortuary science. (a) A funeral director or embalmer license and a funeral establishment permit expires on December 31 of all even-numbered years. The following fees are established for funeral directors, embalmers, and funeral establishments:

- (1) nonrefundable application fee for initial license or permit, \$150 [\$100];
- (2) license or permit fee for all or part of the initial license or permit period, \$275 [\$225];
 - (3) biennial license or permit renewal fee, \$275 [\$225];
 - (4) state law examination fee, **§100** [\$60].
 - (b) The following fees are established for funeral director or embalmer trainee permits:
 - (1) application fee for initial permit, <u>\$150</u> [\$100];
 - (2) trainee permit issuance and renewal fee, \$100 [\$80].
- (c) Permit fee for disposal of human remains for compensation by a person not licensed under AS 08.42 is \$75 [\$50].
