SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
18 AAC 75.341(d) (Table B2)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulation to be revised is 18 AAC 75.341(d) (Table B2), as filed by the Lieutenant Governor's office on October 7, 2016, to appear in Register 220 (January 2017), with an effective date of November 6, 2016 (Department of Law file number JU2015200567). The revisions to Table B2 in that subsection are on page 26 of the transmitted draft, as follows:

--Under the subheadings "Under 40 Inch Zone" and "Over 40 Inch Zone" are sub-subheadings for "Ingestion (mg/kg)" and "Inhalation (mg/kg)", followed by superscript footnote references; for the "Ingestion (mg/kg)" sub-subheading, at both appearances, change the superscript footnote reference from "¹⁶" to "¹⁸"; for the "Inhalation (mg/kg)" sub-subheading, at both appearances, change the superscript footnote reference from "¹⁷" to "¹⁹"

The above changes are necessary so that the superscript footnote references correspond correctly to the numbered footnotes that follow Table B2 and that explain the "Ingestion" and "Inhalation" concepts. Please note that in Table B2, under the subheading "Arctic Zone", the sub-subheadings for "Ingestion (mg/kg)" and "Inhalation (mg/kg)" have the accurate superscript footnote references, and do not need correction.
