Regulations re: restaurant designation permits (3 AAC 304.715(a))

We have reviewed the attached regulations from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated November 14, 2016 from the regulations attorney. The regulations update procedures and requirements for certain license types to be designated a restaurant, in particular to address license types more recently established under statute.

We find no legal problems with the regulations. Though the attached affidavit of agency record refers to the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office not receiving public comments, that office serves as support staff to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board: the agency that considers public comments and formally keeps the record of public comments. The certification order indicates that the board did not receive public comments for this project. The informal reference in the affidavit to the board's support staff is not a substantive violation of the Administrative Procedure Act. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The May 17, 2016 public notice and the September 21, 2016 certification order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
