

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST OF THE COPPER RIVER MERIDIAN, ALASKA

SEGREGATION OF GLENN HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY
AND U.S. SURVEY No. 3197

This plat of a portion of T. 4 N., R. 2 W., C.E.M., Alaska, showing the segregation of a right-of-way 200 feet wide for the Glenn Highway and a portion of U. S. Survey No. 3197, is based upon the plat accepted July 22, 1947, the record of U. S. Survey No. 3197, and a survey of the center line of the Glenn Highway executed by Jack C. Means, Cadastral Engineer, September 29 to October 2, 1951, - (Group 60, Alaska.)

For intermediate bearings and distances along center line of highway, see field notes.

Ties to corners are given from the tangents of curves in the field notes. Distances shown on the plat are calculated from the curve of the right-of-way boundaries.
