1. **QUESTION:** IRFP 170007319 section 4.01 states that the contractor must provide students the tools necessary to obtain Pro Board certification, but the State of Alaska does not certify to Pro Board, is IFSAC (State of Alaska) certification acceptable?

**AWNSER:** The IFSAC certification through the Fire Standards Council of AK is acceptable.

2. QUESTION: Section 1.05 Location of Work states that the course is to be taught in the State of Alaska. Historically this training has been required to be held in Anchorage, presumably because that is where the majority of the students reside. Will the location that the bidder selects for the training be a consideration for the selection of the vendor? For Example: A vendor proposes to conduct the training in remote Alaska for less money, but the location selected will cost the State more in student travel expenses, will that affect vendor selection?

**AWNSER:** No, a vendor may choose to conduct the training anywhere in Alaska that meets the facility and other requirements outlined in the IRFP. State travel costs for students will not be a factor in final selection.
