Offerors may request certain information, such as trade secrets or other proprietary data, to be withheld from public disclosure. Requests for confidentiality must be in writing, clearly identify the specific information to be held confidential, and include a statement that describes why the information is a trade secret or otherwise proprietary. The procurement officer must agree in writing with the request for the information to be held confidential. Unless the procurement officer agrees in writing, the information may become public.
