In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error.

The regulation to be revised is 12 AAC 02.600(d), as filed by the Lieutenant Governor's office on March 29, 2017 (Department of Law file number JU2016200826), that will take effect April 28, 2017, and that will appear in print in Register 222 (July 2017). The revision to that subsection is as follows:

--After "may not", delete the second (duplicative) appearance of the word "not"
