### Chapter 79. Massage Therapists.

(c) An applicant for renewal under (a)(2) of this section may receive four hours of continuing education credit for completion of a bloodborne pathogens and universal <u>and</u> <u>standard</u> precautions course once every six years.

12 AAC 79.210(d)(2) is amended to read:

(2) regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher education; a course, seminar, workshop, or other program through that institution must be approved by the board as directly related to the skills and knowledge required for the practice of massage therapy, and includes a bloodborne pathogens and universal <u>and standard</u> precautions course under (c) of this section; or

12 AAC 79.210 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

- (g) An applicant for renewal under (a) of this section may receive one continuing education credit for attending at least 80 percent of a regularly scheduled board meeting once every biennial licensing period.
- (h) An applicant for renewal under (a) of this section who has been licensed more than 90 days but less than 12 months of the concluding license period shall not be required to submit proof of completion of continuing education.
