Alcoholic Beverage Control Board regulations re: common carrier dispensary licenses (3 AAC

304.340(e) - (g))

We have reviewed the attached regulations from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a general delegation dated December 5, 2014 from the regulations attorney. The regulations adopt provisions to address the circumstances in which persons younger than 21 years of age may, in the course of employment or during passenger travel, enter and remain within the licensed premises of a common carrier, including a marine vessel or an aircraft.

We find no legal problems with the regulations. Though the attached affidavit of agency record refers to the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office keeping the record of use or rejection of public comments, that office serves as support staff to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board: the agency that considers public comments and formally keeps the record of public comments. The certification of adoption order indicates that the board considered public comments for this project. The informal reference in the affidavit to the board's support staff is not a substantive violation of the Administrative Procedure Act. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The February 28, 2017 public notice and the June 6, 2017 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt regulations to amend 3 AAC 304.340. These proposed regulations relate to common carrier dispensary licenses.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt regulations in Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with common carrier dispensary licenses.

3 AAC 304.340 – Common carrier dispensary licenses regulations are proposed to be amended by adding a new section clarifying age requirements and guidelines for employees of common carriers licensees.
