3 AAC 304.340 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

3 AAC 304.340 Common Carrier Dispensary License (e) A person 16 or 17 years of age may enter and remain within the licensed premises of a common carrier in the course of employment if

- (1) the employment does not involve the serving, selling, mixing, delivering, or dispensing of alcoholic beverages;
 - (2) the person has the written consent of a parent or guardian; and
 - (3) an exemption from the prohibition of AS 23.10.355 is granted by the

- Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

(f) A person 18, 19, or 20 years of age may enter and remain within a common carrier in the course of employment if the employment does not involve serving, selling, mixing, delivering, or dispensing of alcoholic beverages.

(g) A person under the age of 21 may enter and remain within a common carrier during passenger travel without a parent or guardian. (Eff. 11/6/2004, Register 172;
