SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
7 AAC 160.900(a)(25) and (26)
and (d)(51) - (53)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are 7 AAC 160.900(a)(25) and (26) and (d)(51) - (53). The revisions to those paragraphs are identical, as follows:

--At the end of 7 AAC 160.900(a)(25), make the semicolon normal font, rather than italicized

--At the end of each other paragraph, change the period to a semicolon; for 7 AAC 160.900(a)(26), please make the semicolon normal font, not italicized

For now, retain the period at the end of 7 AAC 160.900(d)(54); but please note that effective July 22, 2017, Register 223, a new paragraph will be added at the end of 7 AAC 160.900(d). When preparing the October 2017 quarterly supplement for print (Register 223), please make a conforming change to 7 AAC 160.900(d)(54), to replace the period with a semicolon, and to reflect the addition of new 7 AAC 160.900(d)(55).
